



ITINERARY

Day 1: Feb 10th, 2026

- Begin your journey with coffee and snacks at an airport café upon arrival at Nairobi
 Airport
- Depart for Amboseli National Park, known for its stunning views of Mount Kilimanjaro and iconic elephant herds (~4 hours drive from Nairobi)
- On arrival, check in to the camp, refresh, and enjoy a hearty lunch
- Head out for your first game drive around 3 pm in Amboseli and explore its vast plains and diverse wildlife
- · Return to camp for dinner and rest

Day 2: Feb 11th, 2026

- 5:00 AM: Wake-up call and get ready for an early morning game drive in Amboseli National Park
- · Head out with a packed breakfast, allowing us to maximise wildlife sightings
- Continue the game drive until 1:30 PM, exploring Amboseli's rich landscapes and spotting elephants, big cats, and birdlife
- Return to camp for a late lunch and a short rest
- Leave for evening safari around 3 pm to sunset
- Return to camp for dinner and rest



Day 3: Feb 12th, 2026

- Early check out from Amboseli and after breakfast
- Reach Amboseli Airport to take a domestic flight to Mara
- Fly to Mara from Amboseli (about 1.5 hours flight)
- Do game drive from airport on the way to camp and reach camp for lunch
- · Check in and rest for a hour after lunch
- Do an evening walking safari and enjoy exclusive night time sightings at a night hide
- · Return to camp for dinner and rest
- Wind down the day with the sounds of the African bush—hippos grunting, lions roaring, lulling you to sleep under the stars

Day 4: Feb 13th & 14th 2026

- 5:30 AM Wake-up call and get ready for your adventure
- 5:45-6:00 AM Depart for an early morning game drive to witness the breathtaking sunrise over the savannah (around 6:30 AM)
- Spend the full day exploring the vast, wildlife-rich landscapes of the Masai Mara on a full-day safari
- Breakfast and lunch will be served inside the national park, surrounded by stunning views and roaming game
- 6:30 PM Return to camp as the sun sets, hearts full and cameras brimming with memories
- 7:45 PM Enjoy a warm, hearty dinner back at camp
- Unwind and fall asleep to the wild symphony of the Mara



Day 6: February 15th, 2026

- 5:30 AM Wake-up call and experience the beautiful bird hide where the birds come to you and you can sit and enjoy watching the birds of Mara
- 9:00 AM Freshen up, and enjoy a hearty breakfast
- 10:00 AM Check out and start our drive back to Nairobi
- Afternoon Stop for a quick lunch and souvenir shopping en route to Nairobi
- Drive through the scenic Great Rift Valley with a photo stop, weather permitting
- Evening Trip concludes with a drop-off at Nairobi Airport (estimated arrival: 7:00 PM) for your onward journey


Note: For participants flying out the next morning, hotel stay near the airport can be arranged at an additional cost.



SAFARIS

We'll depart from our camp at 5:30 AM for a full-day game drive inside the National Reserve, carrying packed breakfast and lunch (on full day game drive days). We'll spend the day exploring the vast savannah and return to camp by 6:30 PM.

You'll be accompanied throughout by Mahesh Subramanian, our Seasoned Wildlife Expert and Photographer, who will share valuable insights into animal behaviour and provide personalised photography guidance to help you capture the magic of the wild.



BIRDS, MAMMALS AND MORE

Kenya offers an incredible variety of birds, mammals, and scavengers, making it one of the most spectacular wildlife experiences on Earth. Here, you can witness lions up close, observe predators with their kill, and experience the raw behaviours of wildlife and scavengers in action.

The sunrises and sunsets are nothing short of magical—ideal for capturing those perfect silhouette shots you've always dreamed of.

In short, it's National Geographic and Discovery Channel—brought to life.

COST

The total cost of the experience is ₹2,30,000 INR per person.

Additional cost:

- Return flights from India to Nairobi
- Flight from Amboseli to Mara (~350 USD)
- Visa cost (~35 USD)
- Yellow Fever vaccination (Rs 500)

You'll be staying at camps located right next to the national reserves, placing you in the heart of the wilderness. Wake up to the sounds of the savannah and fall asleep beneath a sky full of stars.

YELLOW FEVER VACCINE

Please note that the Yellow Fever vaccine is mandatory for entry into Kenya. You can get vaccinated at any government-approved hospital or authorised center in your district or country.

- Ensure that your vaccine certificate matches the exact details on your passport (name, date of birth, passport number)
- Cost in India: Approximately ₹500
- Don't forget to carry the original Yellow Fever vaccination card with you—it is one of the essential travel documents for immigration.
- The certificate is valid for life, so store it safely for future travel to Africa.

VISA DETAILS

Kenya has replaced the traditional visa with an ETA (Electronic Travel Authorization). The application process remains simple and user-friendly.

How to Apply:

- Apply online using the official portal:
- https://www.etakenya.go.ke/en
- The process is straightforward and fully digital
- ETA approval usually takes 48 working hours

Documents Required:

- A valid passport (with at least 6 months validity from date of travel)
- Flight tickets
- · Hotel booking confirmation

\$35 USD (payable online during application)

VISA PACKING & TRAVEL TIPS____

Essential Documents

- Passport (with at least 6 months validity)
- 2 Photocopies of your passport
- Flight tickets (digital & printed)
- Original Yellow Fever vaccination certificate (mandatory for entry)
- Sufficient cash in USD cash withdrawal options are limited

Clothing & Comfort

- Wear neutral colours or camouflage for safaris (avoid bright colours)
- Dress in layers mornings can be cold, afternoons hot
- Comfortable walking shoes and a light jacket

Health & Hygiene

- Sunscreen the sun can be harsh even on cool days
- First aid kit include any personal medications
- Insect repellent essential for outdoor areas
- Refillable water bottle water will be available at the camp for refills
- Snacks or energy bars -useful during long game drives
